Our Habitat

Canopy St Albans is a beautifully designed children's nursery located in the former United Reform Church in the heart of Bricket Wood, a village community to the South of St Albans which is highly accessible from the M1 and M25.





This L shaped, single storey building has large windows on both sides, filling the 3 large rooms with light, as well as bifold doors to the rear, giving each room its own access to the extensive gardens.







The Canopy Children's Nursery

We welcome children from birth until they start school.

In the nursery we have three distinct environments to enable age-appropriate development, together with free-flow access to the gardens:

- Hazel: Babies from birth to two years old
- Beech: Toddlers from two to three years old
- Oak: Preschool children from three to four years old

Curriculum

At Canopy we look at the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage through the eyes of children to develop a truly engaging curriculum called The Canopy Code. It is a blended approach based on aspects of the Reggio Emilia ethos which views young children as individuals who are curious about their world and have the powerful potential to learn from all that surrounds them. Curious explorers, confident communicators, independent learners and inquisitive thinkers are the life skills, attitudes and behaviours we nurture in our children. Your child's specific interests and needs will influence how our curriculum is delivered, enabling them to follow their passions and discover their powers.

Partnership

We will involve you, listen to you and communicate openly and honestly with you so that we become your trusted partners in ensuring your child reaches their full potential.



Healthy Routines

During their day at Canopy, your child will sit down with other children for freshly prepared organic meals and snacks, relax in a quiet, comfortable environment to rest/sleep and will learn new ways to challenge their physical development.

Fees

Fees are fully inclusive of meals, drinks and snacks. We ask parents to supply nappies and formula/breast milk only.

Security

The safety and security of your child is always our number one priority and is a rigorously enforced via state-of-the security systems.

At Canopy we pride ourselves on being fully inclusive and actively celebrate diversity. We are experienced at providing personalised routines for children with specialist needs. We always start with the child, get to know them and help them feel settled and comfortable and then we work with parents/carers and external advisors to create an individual plan to help your child thrive.
