Our extensive outdoor gardens and Tree Tops indoor adventure playground provide endless opportunities for physical development, discovery, and imaginative exploration. For quieter moments, children can retreat to The Cocoon — a calming sensory space designed to support wellbeing, emotional regulation, and a sense of peace during the day.







Canopy Children's Nursery

Canopy Vine Lodge is a thoughtfully designed, modern nursery where children from birth to school age are supported to grow, play, and thrive. Each room has been carefully considered, with brand-new, ageappropriate furniture and resources that create warm, inspiring spaces tailored to every stage of development. It's a place where little ones feel safe, supported, and free to flourish.

- **Saplings** Babies from 18 months - 2 years old

- **Sunbeams** Toddlers 2-3 years old

- **The Glade** Children from 3 to 3.5 years

- **The Forest** Children from 3.5 to 5 years old.

Curriculum

At Canopy we look at the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage through the eyes of children to develop a truly engaging curriculum called The Canopy Code. It is a blended approach based on aspects of the Reggio Emilia ethos which views young children as individuals who are curious about their world and have the powerful potential to learn from all that surrounds them. Curious Explorers, Confident Communicators, Independent Learners and Inquisitive Thinkers are the life skills, attitudes and behaviours we nurture in our children. Your child's specific interests and needs will influence how our curriculum is delivered, enabling them to follow their passions and discover their powers.

Partnership

We will involve you, listen to you and communicate openly and honestly with you so that we become your trusted partners in ensuring your child reaches their full potential.

Healthy Routines

During their day at Canopy, your child will sit down with other children for freshly prepared organic meals and snacks, relax in a quiet, comfortable environment to rest/sleep and will learn new ways to challenge their physical development.

Fees

Fees are fully inclusive of meals, drinks and snacks. We ask parents to supply nappies and formula/breast milk only.

Early Education Funding

We are able to offer funded places for children from 9 months to 4 years subject to eligibility criteria. There is a service fee for our premium offering of extended opening hours, high quality meals and snacks together with extra curricular activities.

Security

The safety and security of your child is always our number one priority and is rigorously enforced via state-of-the art security systems.

Inclusivity

At Canopy we pride ourselves on being fully inclusive and actively celebrate diversity. We are experienced at providing personalised routines for children with specialist needs. We always start with the child, get to know them and help them feel settled and comfortable and then we work with parents/carers and external advisors to create an individual plan to help your child thrive.
